BRUNSWICK COUNTY DEMOCRATS PRAISE SUCCESSFUL BOB FULTON PETITION PUSH

The Brunswick County Democratic Party (BCDP) praised Robert (Bob) Fulton for successfully completing a challenging petition process to add his name to the November election ballot for the County Commission.

“This is a great day for Bob, and a great day for Democrats,” said BCDP Chair Shelley Allen. “But it’s an even greater day for the voters of Brunswick County. Now that Bob will appear as an unaffiliated candidate on the ballot, voters can choose this November whether to replace an incumbent embraced by developers with an innovator who will protect our county from over-development.”

Because Fulton stepped up to run for office after the filing deadline, he had to convince at least 5,222 residents to sign a petition in support of his candidacy. Working with the BCDP, he collected over 5,600 valid signatures by the Primary Election Day deadline, more than enough to meet the required number.

Fulton praised the work of the volunteers who turned out and helped him collect signatures. “I’m overwhelmed with gratitude for the work our team did to gather the signatures we needed to support my candidacy,” Fulton said. “It’s heartening to know there is a base of support for the issues I plan to pursue in the months leading to Election Day.”

“This election is about the future of our county,” Fulton continued, “and my belief that if we are going to have the kind of county we all hope for -- prosperous and thriving — we need to reexamine how we are growing. We need to develop a more sustainable approach that considers the long-term effects of the decisions made today on our county of tomorrow. I’m excited about engaging with all Brunswick County voters as we chart our path forward.”
