## BRUNSWICK COUNTY COALITION TO PROTEST ROBINSON VISIT

A broad coalition of Brunswick County organizations opposed to Mark Robinson and his campaign for governor of North Carolina is set to protest a visit by the Republican candidate at the St. James Community Center on Thursday, June 27 at 4 p.m.

BCDP Party Chair Shelley Allen said MAGA Republican support of Robinson including his endorsement by convicted felon Donald Trump — are enough to repel any fair-minded voter. "Robinson's offensive statements on issues ranging from reproductive rights to denying the Holocaust to calling LGBTQ people 'filth' cannot go unaddressed," Allen said. "He's not our governor now, and he won't be elected our governor come Election Day."
